2022 SWIMMING POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

We reserve the right to remove anyone from the pool should any of the rules be violated.

NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK

- All residents and guests must sign-in and present pool badge.
- **Abusive language, shouting, rough play, water tag, ball playing, running, misuse of equipment, or any activity that prevents others from enjoying the pool are specifically PROHIBITED.**
- **NO JUMPING OR DIVING IS PERMITTED.** Serious injury may result.
- Swimming is permitted only during published "Open" hours of the pool.
- Glass of any kind is strictly prohibited anywhere within the entire pool area.
- No swimming under the influence.
- Swimsuits must be worn in the pool. Swimming in shorts, skirts, or street clothes is not permitted.
- Shower before entering pool.
- No diapers allowed. All children not potty-trained must wear a swim diaper or similar protection
- Persons with contagious or infectious health conditions are not allowed in the pool area.
- Persons with excessive sunburn, open blisters, cuts, or bandages are not allowed in pool area.
- Persons experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or have had any signs or symptoms of stomach disease in past seven days are not permitted in the pool.
- Pets are not permitted in the pool area at any time.
- Pool facilities, tables and chairs must be shared by everyone. No saving chairs.
- No gum and tobacco. There is "NO SMOKING" within the pool area.
- Music permitted with earphone or volume is low enough not to disturb others.
- Children under the age of 16 **MUST** be accompanied by an adult.
- No children under 16 permitted in hot tubs.
- No littering and No food or drinks near pool deck area.
- Do not prop gates open.
- Rafts, tubes, and water toys are not allowed. (noodles permitted)
- No swimming during rain or thunderstorms.
- No electrical devices on pool deck.
- A phone is available at the pool area for emergency calls **ONLY**.
